

Eindhoven University of Technology

TU/e Talent Scholarship Program

Each year a considerable number of scholarships are awarded by the TU/e partnered by top international technology companies and institutes situated in the Eindhoven region and the rest of the Netherlands. Currently ASML, NXP, Océ, Vredestein and Philips are all involved in TSP. The scholarships are awarded to students with the best grades from their previous education at respected universities outside the Netherlands.

Level of study	Master
Fields of study	Applied Sciences & Technology Mathematics & Computing Engineering
Scholarship coverage	The TSP scholarship covers tuition fees and most living expenses and is worth €17,000 per academic year for students paying the higher tuition fee. The scholarship amount for students paying the lower tuition fee is reduced proportionately. Also a half of the visa and insurance costs of the first year will be covered by the TSP scholarship.
Number of scholarships	Scholarships are awarded for two years, depending on the academic achievements of the student. The student's academic results will be assessed in Spring 2011.
Duration of scholarship	The TSP scholarships are for 5 year programs: 2 years studying for your Master's at the TU/e followed by 3 years working at an international organization or a PhD program.
Eligibility criteria	Eligible students have submitted a complete application package for admission to a TU/e master's program before 1 February 2010 for the academic year 2010/2011; are highly talented, excellent students who have achieved a cumulative GPA above 80% of the scale maximum in their Bachelor's degree from an internationally acclaimed university; have not been granted a scholarship by any other scholarship organization. TSP scholarships are not available to Master's students who are already enrolled at TU/e.
Deadline for application	1 February 2010
Application information	Apply to the TU/e Master's program of your choice. Only complete applications, including the online application and the all application documents, that arrive before 1 February 2010 will be eligible to enter the selection procedure for TSP. If you are admitted to a TU/e Master's program AND you have a cumulative grade point average (CGPA) of 80% or higher, you will enter the selection procedure for the TSP scholarships. Students who are admitted to ANY of the TU/e Master's programs automatically take part in the selection procedure for a TSP scholarship.
