Radboud Scholarship Programme

The Radboud Scholarship Programme offers a selected number of talented prospective non-EEA students the opportunity to receive a scholarship to pursue an English-taught Master's degree programme at Radboud University Nijmegen. The Radboud Scholarship Programme is very selective and is only intended for talented students who have obtained outstanding study results and are highly motivated to pursue a Master's degree programme at Radboud University

Level of study	Master
Fields of study	Humanities Law Management Mathematics & Computing Science Social and Behavioural Sciences
Scholarship amount	Selected scholarship receivers will not receive a grant as such: they will have to pay the regular tuition fee for EEA students: in 2009-2010 a tuition fee of €1,620 instead of €6,125, €8,165 or €12,245 depending on the Master's programme they are applying for. Scholarship also covers additional costs for non-EEA students such as costs for visa, residence permit and health and liability insurance.
Number of scholarships	20 each year
Duration of scholarship	= duration of a Master's degree programme In case of a two-year programme: to qualify for the grant during the second year, you need to have passed all courses in the first year and you need to provide the International Office with a letter of recommendation by the Master's degree programme.
Eligibility criteria	Candidates must meet the following requirements: hold a non-EEA passport and should not be eligible for the lower tuition fee. have been fully admitted to the English-taught Master's degree programme. be able to comply with the conditions for obtaining a visa for the Netherlands. have been enrolled at RU as a full-time student for the academic year and Master's degree programme for which the scholarship will be awarded.
Application information	Send your scholarship request form (download from the website) together with: a letter of motivation for the Master's degree programme, two letters of recommendation, Curriculum Vitae, legally certified translations in English of your diplomas and transcripts by an

officially recognised translator.
