Oldendorff Scholarship

Programme	Research Master in Social and Behavioural Sciences
Scholarship amount	monthly allowance for living expenses (a total amount of € 9,600), covering the costs of living expenses for one academic year, both for EEA and non-EEA students. Non-EEA students receive a partial tuition waiver of €7,812. Students pay only €2,484 instead of the high graduate fee of €10,296.
Number of scholarships	5
Duration of scholarship	Since the Research Master is a two year master programme, students are entitled to an Oldendorff Scholarship for the second academic year if they acquire all 60 ECTS of the first year of the Research Master at the end of the first year.
Requirements	Candidates should be admitted to the Research Master; Candidates will be requested to apply for external scholarships like Huygens Scholarship Programme, Bappenas, Stuned and Netherlands Fellowship Programme as well. If a student receives an external scholarship, fully covering tuition waiver and living expenses, the Oldendorff Scholarship (including tuition waiver and living expenses) will be cancelled. If an external scholarship would be less than the Oldendorff Scholarship, the Oldendorff Scholarship will be awarded partially;
Application information	All international students who are admitted to the Research Master are automatically considered for the Oldendorff Scholarship.
