Fields of study	Applied Sciences & Technology Mathematics & Computing  Engineering
Scholarship coverage	Full-cost scholarship including tuition fees, international travel, living allowances and health insurance.
Duration of scholarship	The duration of the Master programme with a maximum of two years.
Eligibility criteria	Candidates for these scholarships should normally be: aged 35 or under. intending to study a subject that will be of significant value in aiding the sustainable development of their home country. of such outstanding academic ability as to be able easily to obtain a place on the MSc programme of their choice. Only students scoring among the best 10%, CGPA 3.5 and higher on a 4-point scale, will be considered fluent in spoken and written English neither a current nor former employee of the Royal Dutch/Shell Group of companies. intending to return and take up permanent residence in their home country/country of residence after completion of the MSc programme accepted by one of the MSc programmes at the University of Twente  Students who already started their studies at the University of Twente are not eligible.
Deadline for application	March 1
Application procedure	In order to get a scholarship for funding your study, you have to be nominated by our admission committee. Evaluation of your nomination only takes place after you have been accepted to one of the master's programmes. If you want to be nominated for a scholarship in case you will be accepted, please indicate at your additional application form which scholarship.
