Wiarda Scholarship

The Wiarda Scholarship offers outstanding prospective non-Dutch students the opportunity to follow the Master's Programme in Legal Research at Utrecht University. The scholarship programme is highly selective. Only candidates of the highest achievement and promise relevant for the Master's programme in Legal Research may receive a scholarship.

Programme	MSc Meteorology, Physical Oceanography
Scholarship amount	maximum of 5,000 Euro per annum for a maximum duration of two years. (Exceptionally the scholarship can take the form of a partial waiver of tuition fees.)
Number of scholarships	2
Duration of scholarship	maximum 24 months.
Eligibility criteria	<p>The applicant must meet the eligibility criteria in order to be considered for one of these scholarships. The applicant should:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">have been admitted to the Prestige Master's Programme in Legal Research;hold a relevant Bachelor's degree or equivalent thereof from a non-Dutch university with a Grade Point Average of 7,5 or higher according to the Dutch grade system. In the Netherlands grades from 1.0 up to 10.0 are used, with 1 being worst and 10 being best.belong to the top 20% of his/her year, as proven by a university statement from the university where the Bachelor's Degree was obtained;include a bachelor's thesis or equivalent thereof;provide two signed and sealed written statements in support of an application for a Wiarda Scholarship by two law professors, whose names and whereabouts are provided, who have a stated knowledge of the academic merits of the applicant; <p>include a motivation letter of one page in which she or he clearly points out why this scholarship should be awarded to her or him, and for what minimum amount of scholarship is applied for.</p>
Selection criteria	<p>Candidates are selected for a scholarship on the basis of the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Their academic excellence and promise in the proposed field of study;The academic quality and concrete results of the preceding education, as evidenced, for example, by grades, test scores, publications, letters of recommendation;The quality and relevance of the motivation letter (academic content, intercultural and communication skills, personal motivation);The quality and feasibility of the financial plan in the application for a place in the Master's programme;The quality of the application itself (completeness, accuracy, consistency);The referees' letters in support of the application.
