The objective of the Anne van den Ban Fund (ABF) is to enable promising MSc students from developing countries and Central and Eastern Europe to study agricultural, food and environmental sciences, mainly at Wageningen University. The philosophy of ABF is that well educated and motivated specialists in these disciplines can play an important role in their home countries in solving the structural agricultural production and environmental problems.

Number of scholarships	In 2008 ABF supported 40 students from 19 different countries: 10 large grants and 30 small grants (less than € 4000)
Eligibility criteria	In addition to the geographical criteria students applying for the fund must meet the following conditions: they must already be accepted for their chosen study at Wageningen they must have achieved good academic results in their own country they must intend to return to their own country at the completion of their degree
